Access



- There is a ramp access to the Practice from the back of the car park if required



- There are accessible toilets and a Changing Places toilet



- There is an induction loop in Reception



- We have health information in large print, easy ready and other languages when requested

How to make an appointment



Telephone 01386 765600



If you need an urgent appointment on the same day telephone at 8.00am



The telephone lines can get very busy. Telephone after 10.30am if it is not urgent



You can come to the Practice and ask for an appointment



You can pre-book an appointment with your usual Doctor. This helps us get to know you better and give you better care

Repeat prescriptions



This means getting more of your usual medication without seeing a Doctor



How to get a repeat prescription:

- Hand in a repeat prescription form any weekday when we are open
- We have a post box on the wall so you do not have to queue
- We can help you fill in the form
- Local chemists can deliver your medication for you. Ask at Reception about this



2 days

- Your prescription should be ready in 2 days



Tests and results



Sometimes the Doctor or Nurse will need to do a test to find out what is the matter with you

Tests will be done in the Practice and then sent away



GP Surgery

You can make an appointment with your Doctor to get the results of your tests



Or you can telephone the Practice on 01386 765600 choosing option 4 for your results from 1.00pm to 3.00pm.



It takes 3 days for most test results to come back to the Practice
